

CARA Basic Amateur Radio Class Syllabus

The CARA Basic Amateur Radio Class will prepare you to write the ISEC (Industry Canada) exam, which will be held on the last class date. The course is structured around the **Coax Publications Basic Study Guide**. Topics include regulations, electronics basics and station setup and operation. The instruction is volunteer by hams who are industry professionals and focus on understanding and learning, not just memorization. Our goal is toward enjoying ham radio as a lifelong learning hobby.

Weekly demonstrations and show-and-tell sessions will support classroom lecture and discussion. It is expected that the student rise to our level of commitment and attend all classes. We understand that life sometimes gets in the way, but view this as team effort, helping each other to learn. Also be prepared to do some weekly study and reading. CARA supports beginners with special demo and operating sessions outside of class. Please note that due to the late 2018 start, be sure to have your book and be ready to start on the first class date - we will be early at 6:30 PM.
